

Nut Free	Camp is a nut free environment Please do not bring any food or snacks containing peanuts or tree nuts
Food in Tenting Areas	No food in the Bosco Tenting areas please We have had bear sightings and don't wish to encourage more
Campfires for Cooking	Grills will be made available by the main campfire pit at the swim beach should you wish to cook any food
Smoking	Allowed in designated areas only. For the Reunion weekend designated areas will be the deck of Mike's (Camp) Cabin; around any campfire pit; at your camp site if butt pails are used. Smoking is not allowed on the grounds in general, in any buildings, or at the main campfire area during campfire programs
Alcohol	Alcohol will be allowed during the Anniversary weekend. Alcohol is to be consumed only at your camp site. Drinking of alcoholic beverages will not be allowed on the general camp grounds, in any building, on the beaches or on the water, or at the main campfire pit. Non breakable beverage containers must be used. Please pick up any empties. Containers for recycling beverage containers, can be found near the Canteen Building and by the Dining Hall.
Showers	Showers are available for use, please remember that we are on a septic tank Please be environmentally responsible
Electrical Hookups	Sorry, the trees still don't have plugs installed. Some things just don't change!
Noise By-laws	Quiet time within the Park is 11:00 p.m. We ask that you help us to keep peace with our neighbours. Remember that sound travels across the lake.
