Explore the nearby forest on day or night hikes, overnight hikes, stargazing, or sunrise experiences. Your days are filled with fun and adventure, but there's also time to soak up some sun on the beach. You can watch the sun set while listening to loons or sit quietly beside a glowing campfire reflecting on the day's events. You can choose all of the activities or only a few.

The outdoor camping experience allows you a chance to re-discover yourself and see others in a new way, or to build group or family closeness. Your group will be warmly welcomed and our competent staff will strive to accommodate your every need. Come join us!



We also offer two off-site camping programs:

WOTS (Wilderness Out-tripping Skills) is a backpacking exploration of our northern forest. While learning skills with a map and compass, the group explores the Narrow Hills eskers, valleys, creeks and lakes. Campers are given the opportunity to camp outdoors, cook over open fires, develop wilderness survival skills and enhance personal qualities.

COTS (Canoe Out-tripping Skills) is a challenging, fast-action canoeing program held on the beautiful lakes and river systems of northern Saskatchewan. COTS includes instruction in canoeing, packing food, outdoor cooking, and many other wilderness skills.
